The NEPA Challenge

NEPA requires that federal agencies analyze potential environmental effects of proposed actions and their alternatives, avoid or minimize adverse effects of proposed actions, and restore and enhance environmental quality.

EPA-compliant review is typically required for any project that a federal agency funds or regulates.

- Historic sites
- Flood plains

- Up-to-date Federal Fish and Wildlife data, plus 16 new state registries
- State Historic Sites (SHPO) from 55 databases, several with enhanced property boundaries
- National Register of Historic Places
- Flood plains, updated to new FIRM data where available
- National Wetlands Inventory coverage, plus 41 state-level wetlands databases
- FCC antenna/towers and AM radio towers
- Coastal zone management areas
